- **Children's Services Portal:**

<p>Indoor Programs - Programs are first-come, first serve at the door</p> <p>Ages Birth to 6 Years - Participants include adults and children</p> <p>Family Time - This program offers an opportunity for parents, caregivers and their children to meet others and play interactively in an early learning environment. The program will include creative, stories, rhymes, music, language and math. Programs are between 2 hours to 2 and ½ hours long. Each program is limited to:</p> <p>Elm Drive – Tuesday to Friday daytime: 60 participants Tuesday evenings: 50 participants Saturday mornings: 50 participants St. Bernadette – 25 participants Nahani Way – 30 participants</p>	
<p>Jump! Hop! Run! – This is an active program focused on developing large and small muscle skills, while children jump, hop, reach, stretch, climb and more! This program encourages children to try new movements, take safe risks and play cooperative games. It also builds confidence and challenges children to explore beyond their comfort zone. Circle Time is <u>not offered</u> with this program. Programs are 1 and ¼ hours long. Each program is limited to: Elm Drive – 60 participants</p>	
<p>Music & Movement (Indoor) - Music and movement are important elements of a child's development. These activities build young minds and bodies. Join us for movement activities, songs and stories. (This program is best suited for children who are mobile.) Programs are 2 and ¼ hours long. Each program is limited to: St. Bernadette – 25 participants</p>	
<p>Open Door - This is an opportunity to explore the early learning play areas within the centre. The staff are available to answer questions, provide resources and make referrals for families. Programs are between 1 hour to 2 hours long. Each program is limited to: Elm Drive – Wednesday afternoons: 60 participants Monday & Thursday afternoons: 10 participants</p>	
<p>Playtime with Dad - This program is an opportunity for dads, grandpas, uncles and other male caregivers to interact with their children and meet others in an early learning environment. The program will include: creative, sensory, stories, rhymes, music, language, math and physical activities. (Moms, grandmas, aunts and other female caregivers – this is a great opportunity for you to enjoy some time for yourself!) Programs are 2 hours long. <p>Zumbini® - Pre-Registered Program – This is a movement-based program which provides the opportunity for children to experience the sounds and rhythm of the music and movement. Zumbini® also encourages parent-child bonding while helping to develop cognitive abilities, motor and social skills, language, and emotional well-being. It is also a fun workout for parents! Peel Public Health – Oral Health Free Dental Screening and Fluoride – Pre-Registered – A dental screening is a quick assessment by a Registered Dental Hygienist who will take a look inside the child's mouth. A separate, sterilized mouth mirror is used for each child. If a child needs additional dental care, a form will be sent home and the parent may be contacted by a dental staff member. **Please bring your child's Health Card, ID for the parent (something with your address) and Healthy Smiles Ontario card (if you have one). The legal guardian is required to fill out a consent form for each child and the form(s) must be brought with the child(ren) to the appointment. Consent form(s) need to be picked up from Elm Drive EarlyON by April 14, 2026.**

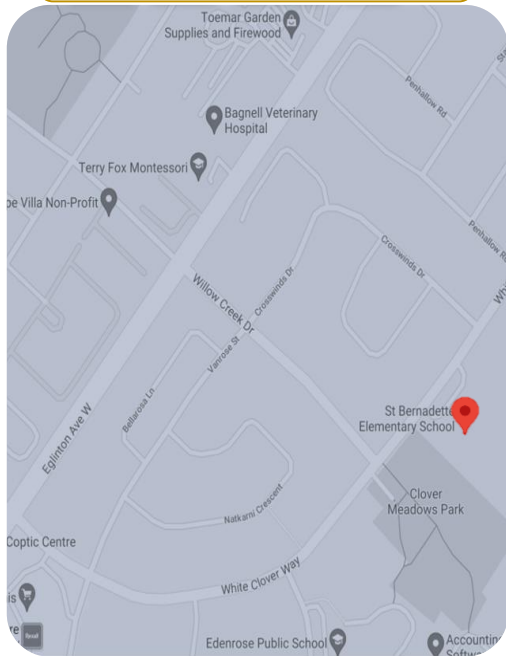

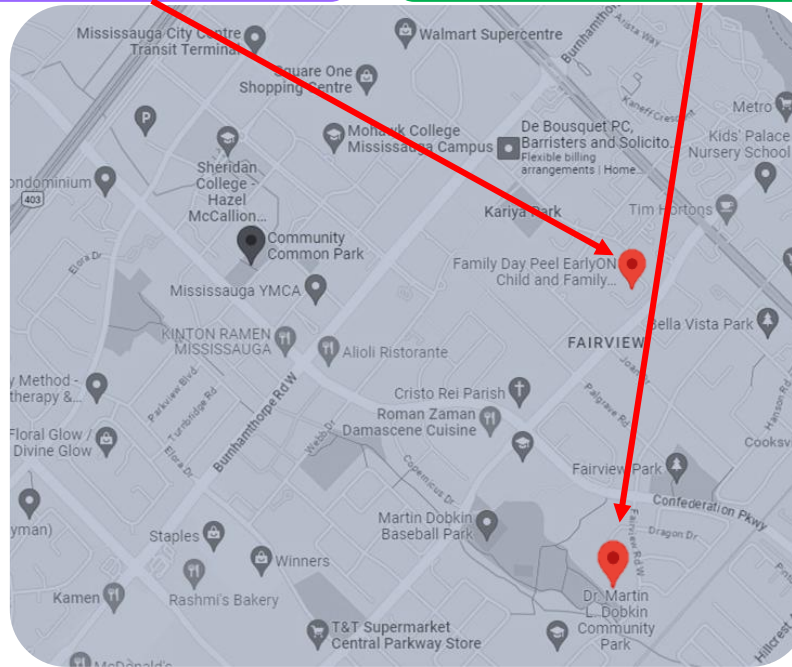

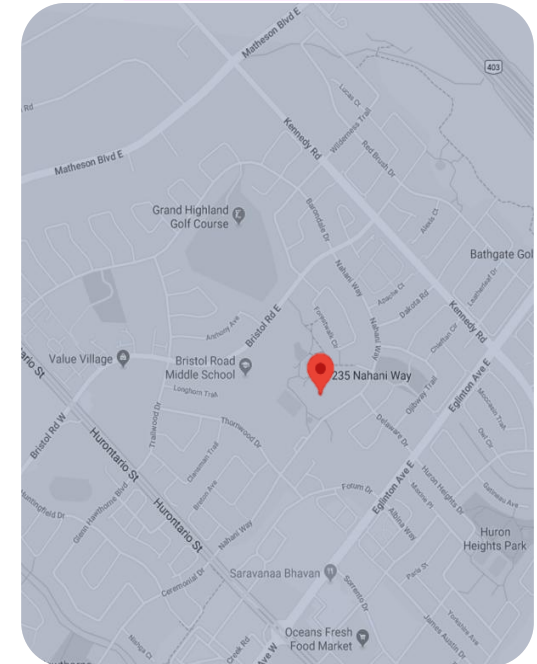
