

Registered Program Descriptions

Parenting Programs

***Triple P - Primary Care* (for parents/caregivers of children from 1 to 6 years) - Individual Phone Consultation**

Our staff will provide some practical strategies for managing children's behaviour of the listed topic. The consultation would involve half an hour scheduled phone contact 2 to 4 times and working on a parenting plan to help manage your children's challenging behaviour.

Disobedience (age 1 to 6 yrs.) Consultation date: Monday January 4th, 11th, 18th & 25th (12:00-2:00pm) and Tuesday January 5th, 12th, 19th & 26th (12:00-2:00pm)

Mealtime problems (age 3 to 6 yrs.) Consultation date: Tuesday 5th, 12th, 19th & 26th (2:00-4:00pm)

Bedtime problems (age 1 to 3 yrs.) Consultation date: Friday January 9th, 16th, 23rd & 30th (11:00-1:00pm)

Toilet Training (age 1 to 3 yrs.) Consultation date: Thursday January 7th, 14th, 21st & 28th (2:00-4:00pm)

***Triple P - Seminar Series* (for parents/caregivers of children 1- 6 years old) 6 session program with 3 individual topic via Zoom**

Triple P is a unique, multilevel family program for the treatment and prevention of behavioural and emotional problems in children.

(I) The Power of Positive Parenting will teach you how you can help your child become confident and successful – at school and beyond. Find out ways to encourage them to be respectful and considerate, communicate and get on well with others, feel good about themselves and become independent problem solvers.

(II) Raising Confident, Competent Children will teach you how You can help your child become confident and successful – at school and beyond. Find out ways to encourage them to be respectful and considerate, communicate and get on well with others, feel good about themselves and become independent problem solvers.

(III) Raising Resilient Children will teach you how you can help your child manage their emotions, so they cope well with disappointment and in stressful situations? Get the strategies that will allow them to recognize positive and negative emotions – and deal with them in a healthy way.

Registration will be opened on Eventbrite on January 4th for “Power of Positive Parenting”, January 11th for “Raising Confident and Competent Children” and January 18th for “Raising Resilient Children”. This program is offered on Wednesday and Friday from January 13th to January 29th (10:00-11:00am).

***Reaching In, Reaching Out* (for parents/caregivers of children from birth to 6 years old) 3 week program via Zoom**

This workshop will support parents in developing effective coping strategies and build upon their resiliency skills, in order to enhance parent-child relationships.
