<p>Babies in Playland – Birth to 18 months Parents/caregivers and babies participate together in early learning activities that help to stimulate cognitive, physical and social development. Information on early childhood development will be available.</p>	<p>Playful Math - 2 to 6 years old This program provides hands on activities for parents and caregivers to support their children early math skills by messing about, playing and tinkering with loose parts. Emphasis is on developing provocations in the different strands of Mathematics.</p>
<p>Singable Stories for Babies – Birth to 18 months This program focuses on a variety of story-telling methods, story songs, story-telling with props, and reading from a book. Parents/caregivers are encouraged to try these different methods at home.</p>	<p>Family Time – Birth to 6 years Family Time is for parents/caregivers and their children to meet others and play interactively in an early learning environment. The program includes; arts and crafts, music, pre-reading, and math concepts.</p>
<p>Tot Stop – 18 months to 36 months This program focuses on toddler development through play. Parents/caregivers engage in activities with their children including, arts and crafts, sensory activities, songs and rhymes.</p>	<p>Open Door – Birth to 6 years Come and explore our centre and the many services and resources available to you. Families are welcome to come and play with their children when regular programs are not being offered.</p>
<p>Messy Play – 18 months to 6 years This program focuses on exploring our five senses through a variety of multi-sensorial activities. Sensory experiences stimulate children and give them new information about the world.</p>	<p>Parenting Information and Referrals Staff members are available to meet individually with families to discuss any concerns and to provide information on child development or community resources.</p>
